

General Information 2013 National Scout Jamboree For Youth, Leaders, Staff

Get ready for ADVENTURE! Registration is open for the 2013 National Scout Jamboree July 15-24, 2013 at the Summit Bechtel Family National Scout Reserve, West Virginia. Experience whitewater rafting, zip-lining, rappelling, mountain biking, hiking, and more! Join 50,000 Scouts and Co-ed Venturing Crews are also welcome!

Monmouth Council has been allotted the following slots for the Jamboree:

- Three Jamboree Boy Scout Troops:
Openings for 108 boys and 12 adult leaders. Each Troop will consist of four patrols of eight boys, four boy leaders, and four adult leaders.
- One Venturing Crew:
Openings for 8 youth and 2 adult leaders (co-ed). The Crew will be placed in a camp site with three other crews making a standard compliment of 40.

Costs: **Adult Leader/Staff Cost:** \$850
 Scout/Crew Cost: \$1,350 Per Scout

Registration Process for Troop & Crew Youth Participants

(See the under age, or grade, female youth crew section below if this applies to you)

*****You must first apply on the National Jamboree website: <https://summit.scouting.org>

- Create an account/password – You will need the following:
 - You must be a registered Scout
 - Your Scout BSA membership ID number
(Check with your unit if you don't have your ID card.)
 - A current digital photograph that can be uploaded
 - Parental permission if you are under 18
- Part I of the Application Process (National Level)
 1. Review National website [instructions](#) before starting the application process <https://summit.scouting.org>
 2. Review the National requirements for attending
 3. Review National [medical/health](#) information and requirements
 4. Complete the online application process
 5. Print the "Request to Attend" form
 6. Obtain required signatures from your home scouting unit leaders
- Part II of the Application Process (Council Level)

Note: Incomplete packages will not be accepted.

2. Bring your completed and "signed" forms to Monmouth Council. Forms must be submitted to Camping Specialist Marjorie Ramirez. Forms will only be accepted during Council business hours.
3. Include a check for \$100 payable to "Monmouth Council, BSA"
4. Forms will be dated the day that they brought or to council and logged with payment.
5. We will notify everyone if scholarship money becomes available. Then you will need to complete the [scholarship application](#).

Youth Selection Process

NOTE: The date you turn in your completed package to council with your deposit is the date that will be used to fill the 108 Troop slots and 8 Crew slots. The date you applied to the National Website does not count.

1. Forms will be accepted on a rolling basis and dated as they arrive.
2. Youth will be informed by e-mail if they have been selected.
3. Applications received after the slots have been filled will be put on a waiting list and notified by e-mail.
4. Please do not call to check on application status. All applicants will be notified within 30 day of their submission.
5. Wait list youth will be contacted if a spot becomes available.

Under age or grade female youth crew section if this applies to you)

If at this time you are a female that intends to join a crew when you meet those requirements and also wish to attend the Jamboree you must follow a slightly different path. Since you are currently not a member skip the Create an account and Part I of the above process. Proceed to Part II and fill out a local Youth Application form and submit it along with your deposit. Take no further action until you officially join a crew and then proceed to go to the national site create an account and complete Part 1 above. You will be placed on our wait list based on the date this form is submitted.

Troop and Crew Leader Application Process

- Follow National Application Process (see above create an Account)
 1. Review National website [instructions](#) before starting the application process <https://summit.scouting.org>
 2. Review the National requirements for attending
 3. Review National [medical/health](#) information and requirements
 4. Apply online, print a copy of the National Application package/forms
 5. Download the Monmouth Council Troop/Crew [Adult Leader Application](#) from <http://jambo.monmouthbsa.com/2013/>
 6. Submit all forms to Monmouth Council.
 7. No application fee is required for adults and no payments are required until you are selected as a Jamboree Leader.

Adult Leader Selection Process

- Leaders will be selected based on their qualifications.
- The date the form is submitted to council does not impact the selection process.
- Selections will be made before April 30, 2012.

If you are put on a waiting list you have three choices:

- You can apply for a [Staff Position](#) through the National Jamboree site. There are over 9,000 staff positions, but there are no guarantees of getting a position on staff.
- You can wait for a Council opening, and if one becomes available you can resign your National staff position in favor of the council leader spot.
- Or, you can just stay on the local wait list, for a council opening, if you do not want to apply for a staff position.

National Jamboree Staff Positions

- There is no local council involvement basically in this process.
- Please let Chris Quakenbush know if you are accepted as a National Staff member.
